- Intro What Every Christian Scientist Should Know About Christian Science Nursing A six-day retreat.

 Members of the Christian Science community join with Christian Science nurse apprentices to explore Jesus' parable of the Good Samaritan and the Church Manual by-law for the Christian Science nurse. With the Pastor as the foundation, attendees sing, laugh, pray, have fun, and share standards and practical tips which enable them to demonstrate how Christian Science nursing enables them to fulfill their duty to God, our Leader, and to mankind.
- **I** Basic Christian Science Nursing a six-week course Begins with the Intro class described above; Christian Science nursing ethics, standards, skills, & care options while giving assistive care & light bed care; care of patients' environment; nourishment; communication; basic cleansing, covering, and bandaging; supportive response to those experiencing immediate care needs.
- II Intermediate Christian Science Nursing a six-week course A review and deepening study of Christian Science nursing ethics, skills, care standards, and care options, while giving care in bed; intermediate cleansing, covering, & bandaging; support for those experiencing immediate care needs; mental needs support; deepening of communication ethics and skills and assessment skills.
- **Advanced Christian Science Nursing a five-week course** A review of Christian Science nursing ethics, standards, & skills; giving care to those with wounds and to those experiencing immediate needs; Intro to giving care to children; Review of II skills; enrichment for communication and assessment skills.
- **Leadership & Communication a six-week course** Grand review of Christian Science nursing ethics, standards, skills; and care options; instruction and mentoring; management; supervision; workshop facilitation and presentation.
- Christian Science Nursing at Camp a three-week course Workshops, mentoring, & instruction; caring for children, teens, & adults with immediate or on-going care needs; review of cleansing, covering, & bandaging ethics, standards, skills, & care options On site at The CedarS Camps in Lebanon, Missouri.

Class fees for 5-6 week courses are \$2,500. Fees include supplies and class-books. Room and board at Glenmont is \$15 per day, on a space-available basis.

Students who have already taken the course at an accredited School of Christian Science Nursing and are taking it as a refresher, may apply to take 2 or more weeks of the course with fees prorated at \$500 per week.

The fee for the Christian Science Nursing at camp course is \$1,200, with room and board included. The individual taking this course must be an experienced Christian Science nurse.

Class dates may be adjusted to meet the needs of the participants.
